नेत्रदान महादान (प्राथमिकता बदलनी होगी)

“रौशनी फाउंडेशन”, एम.एस.ई.बी. के रिटायर्ड कर्मचारियों की संस्था है जो कि लोगों को इस बात के लिये प्रेरित करती है कि मरणोपरांत नेत्रदान करके, दो दृष्टिहीनो के जीवन में रौशनी भरने का काम समाज में किया जाना चाहिये।

रौशनी फाउंडेशन पिछले चार वर्षों से नेत्रदान जागरूकता एवं निःशुल्क नेत्र जांच का शिविर लगाकर नेत्रदान के विषय में जानकारी देती आ रही है, तथा इस विषय में समाज में फैले अंधविश्वास और शंकाओं का समाधान भी करती आ रही है। रौशनी फाउंडेशन के इस छोटे से प्रयास से लगभग १६०० लोग नेत्रदान का संकल्प कर चुके हैं, तथा १९ लोगों ने अब तक मरणोपरांत नेत्रदान जैसा पवित्र कार्य करके दृष्टिहीनो का जीवन रौशनी से भरने का महान कार्य किया है।

भारतवर्ष में लगभग एक करोड़ से भी अधिक लोग अंधत्व से पीड़ित है, इसमें काफी बड़ी संख्या में लोग कार्निअल ब्लाइंड है और वे सामान्य जीवन जीने में असमर्थ है उन्हें हर वक्त किसी ना किसी सहाये की जरूरत महसूस होती है।

वया हम लोग ऐसे लोगों की मदद कर सकते है, ताकि वे लोग भी अपनी आंखों से दुनिया देख सकें एवं आत्मनिर्भरता से जीवन जी सकें?

हाँ, निश्चित रूप से मरणोपरांत नेत्रदान कर हम लोग इन्हे अंधत्व से मुक्ति दिला सकते है।

कोई भी व्यक्ति किसी भी जात, धर्म या उम्र का हो, मृत्यु के पश्चात नेत्रदान करके दो दृष्टिहीन व्यक्तियों के जीवन में रौशनी लाने का पवित्र काम कर सकता है। नये संशोधन से पता चलता है कि भविष्य में एक व्यक्ति नेत्रदान कर चार लोगों के जीवन में रौशनी ला सकेगा।

अंगदान के विषय को लेकर हमारे देश में जागरूकता का अभाव है इसीलिये अंधत्व से मुक्ति पाने में काफी समय लग सकता है। समाज में नेत्रदान के विषय में लोगो को जागरूक कर इसे गति प्रदान की जा सकती है।

इस संबंध में सरकार व गैरसरकारी संगठन अपने अपने तरीको से प्रयास करते आ रहे है, लेकिन उपलब्ध आंकड़ो से पता चलता है कि इस क्षेत्र में बहुत अधिक कार्य करने की आवश्यकता है। एक रिपोर्ट के अनुसार हमारे देश में साल भर में लगभग २५००० कार्निआ प्राप्त होते है जबकि आवश्यकता ५० हजार कार्निआ की है।

सरकार और सामाजिक संगठन समय-समय पर शिविर लगाकर लोगों के बीच उनसे नेत्र दान का संकल्प दिलाकर फॉर्म तो भरवा लेते हैं, लेकिन मृत्यु के पश्चात अधिकतर लोग अनेक कारणों से नेत्र दान नहीं कर पाते।

प्राथमिकता बदलने की जरूरत है

जब कभी भी परिवार में किसी सदस्य की मृत्यु होती है तो उस परिवार के सदस्य व रिश्तेदार सदमे में होते हैं और अपने परिचितों को सूचना देने के बाद अंतिम क्रिया की तैयारी में लग जाते हैं। हमारी प्राथमिकता रिश्तेदारों को सूचना और अंतिम क्रिया की तैयारी की होती है और फिर तिसरा/तेहरवी जैसे सामाजिक व धार्मिक कार्यक्रम में अपने आप को व्यस्त कर लेते हैं।

यदि हमने या हमारे परिवार के किसी भी सदस्य ने नेत्र दान का संकल्प लिया है, तो मृत्यु के पश्चात हमारी प्राथमिकता बदलनी होगी।

परिवार के जिस सदस्य ने नेत्र दान का संकल्प लिया है और उसने अपने संपूर्ण नजदीकी रिश्तेदारों को इस बात से अवगत कराना चाहिए की उसकी मृत्यु के पश्चात (पहली प्राथमिकता) आई बैंक को फोन से सूचना देनी होगी ताकि समय रहते उसके नेत्र दान की प्रक्रिया सफलतापूर्वक हो सके।

परिवार के सदस्यों को इस बात से भी अवगत कराएँ की यह एक सहज व सरल प्रक्रिया है और मृत्यु के छह घंटे के भीतर ही नेत्र दान किया जा सकता है तथा आँखों का कार्निआ निकालने में सिर्फ १५-२० मिनट का ही वक्त लगता है और इसके पश्चात मृतक के चेहरे पर किसी भी प्रकार की कोई कुरूपता नहीं आती है।

अपने जीवन काल में हर व्यक्ति अपनी हैसियत के हिसाब से कभी ज्ञान दान, कभी भोजन दान, कभी रक्त दान व अन्य तरीकों से जरूरत मंद लोगों की मदद करता रहता है। हम सब जानते हैं कि मृत्यु के पश्चात आत्मा अनंत में विलीन हो जाती है और हम मृत शरीर को सिर्फ जलाते या दफनाते हैं। मनुष्य इस बात से अनभिज्ञ रहता है कि मृत्यु के बाद नेत्र दान या देह दान भी करके समाज के प्रति अपने कर्तव्यों का वहन कर सकता है।

समाज में थोड़ी सी जागरूकता से हम लोगों को नेत्र दान करने के लिए प्रेरित कर सकते हैं और मृतक के परिवार को उनकी प्राथमिकता तय करने में मदद कर सकते हैं। तो आइये हम सब मिलकर इस बात का संकल्प करें की मृत्यु के पश्चात आई बैंक को सूचना देना ही हमारी पहली प्राथमिकता होगी, अन्य जरूरी सामाजिक व धार्मिक कार्य तो अपने आप संपन्न हो ही जायेंगे।

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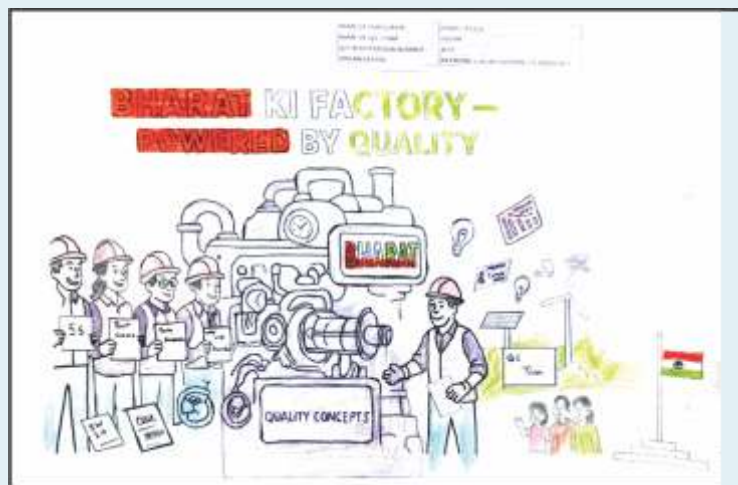
